

## **SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

To be considered for a scholarship award, the following requirements must be satisfied. **Applicants must:** · **Be a Minority high school senior who lives and/or attends school in the Municipality of Anchorage.** · **Complete the *Alaska Alumnae Chapter Scholarship Application*** (must be typed). **Have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.**

- Submit an official high school transcript in a sealed envelope with an official Stamp to the PO Box or emailed to the chapter official email.
- Address on transcript must match address on application
  - Transcripts must include final fall grades (if available)
- **Submit two (2) Letters of Recommendation**
  - One (1) *must* be from a high school guidance counselor, teacher or principal.
  - One (1) *must* be from a community service representative.
    - Letters of Recommendation must be typed and on official letterhead or with a business card attached and cannot come from family members. Letters can be scanned and emailed to the official chapter email submitted with an emailed application. Letters should come from individuals who know you well and can attest to your character, leadership ability, commitment to community service and/or academic achievement.

- **Submit a Personal Statement** (maximum 500 words, [1-2 typed pages], double spaced, Times New Roman, 12pt font), **which must include a response to one of the below prompts. Please type the prompt at the top of the document. You may type and submit as a PDF or Word Document if emailing application to [DSTAlaskaAlumnae@gmail.com](mailto:DSTAlaskaAlumnae@gmail.com).**

1. Describe the world you come from— for example, your family, community or school — and tell us how your world has shaped your dreams and aspirations.
2. Describe an experience that either demonstrates your character or helped to shape it.
3. Tell us about a personal quality, talent, accomplishment, contribution or experience that is important to you. What about this quality or accomplishment makes you proud and how does it relate to the person you are?

- **Submit a photo of yourself (minimum wallet size or digital photo if submitting via email)**

Scholarship recipients may be presented at our May Week celebration or at a citywide event that showcases the accomplishments of the Sorority for the entire year and scholarship recipients. **Recipients should be present virtually, if possible.** Scholarship awards will be sent to schools once verification of enrollment in a four-year college or university is received via email to [dstalaskaalumnae@gmail.com](mailto:dstalaskaalumnae@gmail.com) or mailed to PO box.
